Overview of the Workshop

This workshop will provide an introduction to the theories of child bereavement and loss, exploring how children and young people grieve and perceive death at different ages and stages of development. The workshop will also explore a range of practical therapeutic interventions and effective techniques which can be used in working with bereavement and loss. Individual, pair, and group exercises will equip you to work more effectively with grieving children.

What you will gain from the day

- A greater understanding of ways in which children may express grief and age related reactions to death and loss.
- Knowledge of effective techniques, interventions and resources for engaging children and young people.
- Guidelines for best practice in working with bereaved children.
- Details of reference materials and resources available.
- Enable you to explore and reflect upon you own feelings about loss and bereavement and develop your self awareness.

Counsellors, psychotherapists, and anyone working with young people who wishes to enhance their understanding of loss and grief in relation to children and young people.
